There is no knowing when and where disasters will occur. Preparing against disasters at normal times will help us stay calm in the event of disasters.

Do you have a stock of food and daily necessities in preparation for disasters?

Keep stocks of food and drinking water for about one week or at least for 3 days.

Some daily necessities that should be kept at households in preparation for disasters

Plastic bottles of drinking water, food, portable gas burner, butane gas cartridges, spare dry-cell batteries, toilet paper, packing tape, poly tanks to store and carry water, blankets, garbage and plastic bags, first aid kit and household medicine, paper plates and cups, photos of family members, change of clothes, underwear and socks, diapers, baby formula, portable toilets, and tarps

Commodities to prevent infectious disease

Masks, antiseptics, thermometers, wet wipes, slippers, and plastic gloves

Ouestion:

Do we need to give consideration to the perspective of sex and nationalities of evacuees when evacuation shelters are opened?

Answer:

Yes, we should consider such viewpoints. When a disaster occurs, evacuees with various backgrounds stay together at evacuation shelters for a certain period. Demands of evacuees differ according to their sex, age, abilities and disabilities, cultural backgrounds, and other aspects. We should not cling to stereotypes in doing things, but do whatever each person can do and cooperate so that we can make living conditions more comfortable for everyone.
