## Notifications from Taxation Div. (税務課からのお知らせ)

Taxation Div. ☎ 0561-73-4097

Notifications on Fixed Property Tax and City Planning Tax for 2026 will be sent to you from the beginning of April. The land and building register will be made available for public inspection and the fixed property tax register will be made available for public viewing.

**[Period of Inspection]** April 1 (Wed) ~ 30 (Thurs) excluding Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays

**[Fee]** Free during the browsing period (The fee is 300 yen per sheet at other times.)

**[Place of Inspection]** Taxation Div.

**[Eligibility]** Those who own land, buildings and/or depreciable property in Nisshin

**[Others]** In addition to the above eligible persons, family members who live with them and their agents with Power of Attorney may also inspect the Public Register of Land and Buildings and Fixed Property Tax Register.

# Postponement of National Pension Contribution Payments for Students

(国民年金保険料の学生納付特例制度)

Japan Pension Service

All residents in Japan must enroll in the National Pension System and pay contributions when they turn 20. However, students are allowed to have the payment of their contributions postponed by applying for the special payment system.

**[Eligibility]** Students aged 20 or older whose income in the previous fiscal year is lower than a certain amount

**[How to apply]** You can apply by bringing a copy of your student ID (with expiration date, the year you are in and date of enrollment in the school) or certificate of student status (original) and your My Number Card or other identification to the Insurance and Annuity Div.

Note: Electronic application is also available via the Mynportal website.

## Subsidy for Residential Facilities against Global Warming

(住宅用地球温暖化対策設備の設置費用補助)

Environmental Div. ☎ 0561-73-2883

As part of global warming countermeasures, costs for installing solar panels, household fuel cells, and power storage systems and upgrading to eco-friendly windows will be partially subsidized with the goal of decarbonization of housing.

**[Eligibility]** Persons who install equipment eligible for subsidization at the residences they live in (including newly-built houses and residences used in conjunction with stores, but excluding apartments)

**Note:** Application will close when the budget is reached.

**[How to apply]** Applications will be accepted in person at the Environment Div. starting from 9:00 a.m. on April 1 (Wed). Fill out the specified form (available at the Nisshin City website or at the window of the Environment Div.) and submit it with attached documents at the window.

**[Others]** You need to take procedures both before and after the installation is completed.

## Subsidy for Waste Reduction

(ごみ減量に関する補助金について)

Nisshin City offers a subsidy for the purchase of electric garbage units and containers to turn garbage into compost. The city also rents out electric garbage units to promote waste reduction.

**[Others]** Application will close when the budget is reached.

Nisshin City offers subsidies to encourage organizations to promote agriculture through the following projects.

### 1) Projects to open farmers markets

**[Eligibility]** Organizations which open farmers markets to produce and sell agricultural products themselves with a goal of interaction between citizens and agriculture

### 2) Projects to pass on traditional cooking and other agricultural culture

**[Eligibility]** Organizations which provide courses on traditional cooking such as bean paste and pickles made from local produce, and which operate projects for promoting inheritance of local agricultural culture, local production and consumption

**[How to apply]** Fill out the specified form (available at the window of the Agricultural Div. and at the website) and submit it to the Agricultural Policy Div. by post or e-mail from April 1 (Wed) to December 28 (Mon).

## School Attendance Support Program for Children and Students in Need

(要保護及び準要保護児童生徒就学援助制度)

Guardians who have financial difficulty paying for school supplies for children in elementary or junior high schools can receive a partial subsidy for these fees.

Tuitions for free schools and other expenses to ensure children's opportunity to learn can be provided to guardians of children who are unable to attend school (with income limitation).
