●To persons who are under 60: How to apply for a vaccination ticket

- ① Send the postal card for application enclosed with the notice regarding vaccinations sent by the City. or
- ② Apply online. (You can find the e-mail address and other information in the notice.) or
- ③ Apply directly at the window of Health Center of the City.

Note: You can make a reservation only after you have received your vaccination ticket. A reservation is required to receive the vaccination, so don't forget to make a reservation!

Submission of the Current Condition Form which was required for renewal every June has <u>basically become</u> unnecessary.

However, submission of the form is necessary for recipients whose childrearing condition has changed and for those who meet the following conditions.

- ♦ A recipient who receives the child allowance in a different municipality from the locality of his/her residence to avoid violence from his/her partner
- ♦ A guardian of a child/children with no family register
- ♦ A person in divorce process living separately from his/her partner
- ♦ In addition, persons who receive a notice from the city to submit the Current Condition Form

Notices will be sent to persons who need to submit the Current Condition Form in June. Be sure to confirm the contents and submit the form to Parenting Assistance Div. If your form does not arrive by June 30, the deadline, your child allowance may not be paid on the regular payment day in October. Make sure your form reaches us by the deadline.

- ●Submission period: June 1(Wed) 30 (Thurs) ※The form must arrive by June 30.
- How to submit: Send the Current Condition Form by post to Parenting Assistance Div. in the enclosed return envelope.

The upper income limit will be applied from allowances provided from June 2022. Child Allowance shall not be provided to childrearing persons with incomes on and above the upper income limit.

Other points

The Parenting Assistance Div. will contact you if something that needs to be confirmed comes up.

You will need to take notification procedures if conditions have changed from the previous fiscal year.

Please follow the procedures specified in the guidance provided separately and submit the notification form to the Parenting Assistance Div.

Notices will be sent to persons whose child allowance amounts will be changed from those provided from June 2022 after screening.
