The Covid-19 vaccination program for spring 2023 will start on May 8 (Mon) as described below. Vaccination tickets (light blue-colored) with preliminary examination slips will be sent to eligible persons. You can make a reservation only after you have received your vaccination ticket.

▼ Vaccination period: May 8 (Mon) to August 31 (Thurs) ▼ Number of times: Once ▼ Cost for vaccination: Free

### Eligibility & Vaccination ticket

1) Persons aged 65 years old or over: **No application is needed for a ticket.** Vaccination tickets will be sent to you 3 months after your last shot.

2) **Persons aged between 5 and 64 years old with underlying medical conditions: Application is needed for a ticket if you have never applied for having underlying medical conditions.**

If you have applied for Covid-19 vaccination for having underlying medical conditions, you do not need to apply for a ticket for this program. Based on your previous applications, vaccination tickets will be sent to you 3 months after your last shot.

3) **Persons who work at medical institutions or nursing facilities: Application is needed for a ticket.**

If you have not yet received vaccination against the Omicron variant, a new vaccination ticket will not be sent to you even if you are eligible. Please use your pink vaccination ticket (for Omicron).

People who do not meet any of conditions 1) to 3) above are not eligible for the vaccination program for spring 2023.

**However, children who are aged between 5 and 11 years old and have not yet received vaccination against Omicron can receive vaccination once regardless of whether they have underlying medical conditions.**

**No group-vaccinations are available. Please visit a medical institution to receive vaccination.**

**How to apply for a vaccination ticket:** If you are eligible and need to apply, please apply by either 1) or 2) below

\* Breast and cervical cancer screenings and endoscopic screening for stomach cancer are available every two years. Other tests are available once a year per person.

Applications are processed on a <b>first come, first served basis</b>: Applicants who will be unable to get their desired screening(s) will be notified. Individual cancer screenings	Individual cancer screenings are conducted at designated medical institutions in Nisshin from June through November. Screening Tickets will be sent at the end of May to people aged 40 or older and to people receiving municipal medical screening reminders. * Screening tickets will be enclosed with the leaflet for the Specific Health Checkups for those enrolled in the National Health Insurance System or Long-term Care Insurance System.			
Health checkup for those in their 30s	Health checkups for those in their 30s are conducted at designated medical institutions in Nisshin from June through November. Please apply for checkup tickets by calling Health Promotion Div. (Health Center) or via the Nisshin City website.			
Pneumococcal vaccination for the elderly	<p><b>Routine vaccination:</b> Pneumococcal vaccination tickets will be mailed to persons eligible for the vaccination at the end of May 2023. The deadline for getting inoculations in this fiscal year is March 31, 2024. The vaccination is available at designated medical institutions in Nisshin.</p> <p><b>3000-yen subsidy:</b> Available for people aged 65 or older. For detailed information, contact the Health Center.</p>			

**NOTE:** Some screenings are not available depending on the examinee's health conditions. For further information, please call the Health Promotion Div. (Health Center) or refer to the Nisshin City website or the Health Center Guidebook. People in municipal tax-exempt households or households receiving welfare benefits are exempted from the fees of the examinations at the Health Center, osteoporosis screening and fluoride coating on teeth. A certificate and other documents are needed. For more information, please contact the Health Center. For information about the annual schedule and seminar contents, please check the Health Center Guidebook or the Nisshin City website.

\*Please bring your “Parent-Child” passbook (Maternity passbook) with you. Please request special consideration for disabilities at least 7 days prior to the occasion.

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**Fiscal 2023 Light Motor Vehicle Tax Notice**

Reduced tax rates will be applied to four-wheeled light vehicles, which have undergone their initial inspection in fiscal 2022 and proven to meet designated environmental performance criteria, according to their fuel efficiencies and emission efficiencies only for tax payment for fiscal 2023. For more information, please see the note on Annual Tax of Light Motor Vehicle Tax (category-based tax reduction) enclosed with your tax notice or refer to the Taxation Div.

Note: Payment of the light motor vehicle tax can be made at convenience stores. Payment by a smartphone apps is also available. (Data communication expenses must be paid by users.)

### Consultation Window for Adult Guardianship (成年後見制度に関する相談窓口) [Owari-Tobu Rights Support Center (commonly known as *Asu Rights*)]

This center, established by five cities and one town in the Owari-Tobu District (Nisshin City, Seto City, Owariasahi City, Toyoake City, Nagakute City and Togo Town) provides legal consultation and support regarding adult guardianship for persons concerned and their families.

Adult guardianship is a system designed to provide legal support to persons who have lost their cognitive abilities, due to dementia, intellectual disability, or mental disorder, and have difficulty making sound judgements on their own with regard to contracts or property management.
