OHow to obtain application forms

① Receipt at the City Hall

Application forms will be available between 8:30 a.m. and 5:15 p.m. on weekdays at Conference Room 4 on the second floor of the City Hall, from October 2 (Mon) to 13 (Fri) and at the Children's Div. on the second floor of the City Hall after October 16 (Mon). Please note that there will be no individual explanations.

② Download from the Nisshin City website

Application forms can be downloaded from the Nisshin City website.

③ Receipt by post

Please send an A4-sized return envelope with your address, name, the number of forms you request and your telephone number, and necessary amount of postage stamps attached (210 yen for one copy and 250 yen for two or three copies).

*An enrollment guide will be enclosed with the forms.

*Please contact the Children's Div., if you do not receive the forms one week after you have sent out your return envelope.

OApplications for enrollment

▼ For parents who wish to enroll their child/children in a nursery school from April 1 to September 30, 2024 (application for the initial period)

Please apply in any of the following four ways.

It would be appreciated if you would apply by one of methods $2 \sim 4$.

① At the City Hall

Please bring all the necessary documents to the venue listed at the very end of this article between October 23 (Mon) and November 10 (Fri).

② By post

- Put all the necessary documents in an A4-sized envelope and send them by post so they will arrive at the Children's Div. by November 10 (Fri).
- Note: The Children's Div. will send out a notice confirming reception within a week after you apply. If you do not receive the notice after you have applied, please make sure to contact the Children's Div., because your application documents may not have been properly submitted.

③ Reception Box at the Children's Div.

- Put all the necessary documents in an A4-sized envelope and drop it in the Reception Box set up at the Children's Div. by 5:15 p.m. on November 10 (Fri).
- *The box is available from 8:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. on weekdays.

④ Online application

You can apply online via the Pittari Service provided by the government's Mynaportal website which uses your Individual Number Card (My Number Card) for verification.

The service will be available from October 23 (Mon) to 5:15 p.m. on November 10 (Fri).

Notes: *The Children's Div. will notify applicants in case there are any deficiencies in your application documents for submission by $2 \sim 4$.

*All the necessary documents must be submitted by the deadline. Otherwise, acceptance of applications will not be completed. Make sure to submit the documents ahead of time so that you will be able to take care of any deficiencies.

*Children will undergo one- to two-week childcare for shorter hours after admission to help them get used to their new environment. Therefore, parents who plan to start working by October 14, 2024 are also eligible for application in this initial period.

▼ For parents who wish to enroll their child/children in a nursery school from October 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025 (application after the initial period)

Applications will be accepted from the first day the City Hall is open in the month, 6 months prior to the date you plan to enroll your child. For example, if you wish to have your child/children attend a nursery school from October 10, 2024 (Thurs), you may apply on or after April 1, 2024 (Mon). Please contact the Children's Div. for details. **Note**: Depending on circumstances of application, your child/children may be granted to your second or lower choice, or may even be unable to enter any nursery schools.

OCriteria of approval for nursery school enrollment

All parent who wish to enroll their child/children should meet one of the following criteria:

- ① Parents or guardians who work for 60 hours or more a month;
- ② Mothers who are within the period of having less than 12 weeks before childbirth or 8 weeks after childbirth;
- ③ Parents or guardians who suffer from sickness, injury or physical or mental disorder;
- ④ Parents or guardians caring for a family member living together and suffering from sickness or injury;
- ⑤ Parents or guardians engaged in restoration after a natural disaster or fire;
- (6) Parents or guardians seeking jobs (including those preparing to start a business);
- ⑦ Parents or guardians attending a school (including job training at a vocational school);
- 8 Parents or guardians in similar circumstances and are approved by the mayor, aside from the above $\textcircled{1}{\sim}\textcircled{7}$

Note: In case of ⁽⁶⁾ above, the examination for nursery school enrollment will be started only after the application deadline in March, 2024. This rule will also be applied to applications by parents who will not return to work from childcare leave before April 1, 2024 and wish to enroll their child/children in classes for 3-year-olds or older.

Others

- ① The informal decision on which nursery school your child/children can enroll in is scheduled to be announced in late December.
- ② Please consult the Children's Div. when applying, if you are anxious that your child/children may have difficulty getting along at nursery schools due to retarded development or disability.
- ③ Applications can be accepted even before childbirth, if a Parent-child passbook (Maternity passbook) has been issued and you would like to enroll your baby for infant care (for babies younger than 1 year old).
- ④ Briefing sessions regarding application will not be held. Please watch the video on this subject on the Nisshin City website.
