2. Apply early for collection of oversized waste before the year-end.

Applications for the collection of oversized waste largely increases near the year-end and new-year closure. Do not wait till the last minute to apply to have your application accepted for your desired date. Online application is strongly recommended. The phone line at the oversized waste reception center will be busy and your call may not get through.

You can take your oversized waste on your own to the Togo Bika Center of the Bisan Sanitation Association. However, the center is also crowded before the year-end, and it may take more than one hour for the whole procedure.

So please take steps early to apply for the collection of your oversized waste or to take your oversized waste to the center. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Incineration of household waste is prohibited by law(家庭ごみの焼却は法律で禁止されています)

Burning waste out of doors is prohibited by law. Although, burning of waste when strictly necessary in farming is treated as an exception, you may be reprimanded if you cause trouble in the neighborhood in doing so.

Household waste (including branches and grass) must be put in the designated garbage bags of the City and put out at the collection sites or taken to the Togo Bika Center run by the Bisan Sanitation Association.

Pruned branches that do not fit in the designated bags can be put out for collection by cutting into lengths of less than 70 cm, made into bundles of less than 30 cm, and wrapped around with a designated bag for burnable waste. Please note that branches over 10 cm in diameter are not accepted.

Exemption of National Health Insurance Tax for prenatal and postnatal period (国民健康保険税の産前産後期間の免除)

Insurance and Annuity Div. 2: 0561-73-1420

From January 1, 2024, women who are expecting a child (or children) and covered by the National Health Insurance will become exempt from the per capita based and income-based levy of their insurance tax for four months starting from the month prior to that of the expected date or actual date of delivery. For women expecting multiple children, the exemption period is six months starting from three months prior to the month of the due date or date of delivery.

[Acceptance of notifications] Notifications will be accepted from six months prior to the due date

[Eligibility] Persons covered by National Health Insurance who are expecting to give birth and have been pregnant at least 85 days on or after November 1, 2023.**[How to notify]** Designated forms are distributed at the Insurance and Annuity Division. Fill in the required items and show a document recording your due date and whether you are pregnant with a single baby or multiple babies (in most cases your parent and child handbook). In case of giving notice after a child is born or giving notice of a childbirth in a separate household, attach documents which show the relationship between the insured person who gave birth and the child when applying to the Insurance and Annuity Div.
