More Items to Be Collected as Recyclable Plastic Resources from April 2024

In April 2024, Nisshin City will expand the category for the collection of recyclable plastic resources. Plastic products will also be collected as recyclable plastic resources along with plastic containers and packaging currently collected separately as such. Items which are entirely or mostly made of plastic shall be collected as recyclable plastic resources. Use the following flow chart to see if an item can be collected as plastic resources.

Check if an item can be collected as recyclable plastic resources.

① Does the item have the mark for recyclable plastic or is it made mainly of plastic?

Note: If the item has a metal or other non-plastic part, remove it. Large items which do not fit into a collection bag shall be collected if they are broken down into pieces so they can be put in the bag and the bag can be tied up.

② If it is a container, have you used up its content?

Discard it according to its category.

③ If it is dirty, rinse it or wipe it clean.

Items which are still unclean or smell should be treated as burnable garbage.

(4) Make sure the item does not contain any unacceptable items which may hinder treatment procedures at the recycling facility. For details, refer to the January edition of *Koho Nisshin* or the Nisshin City website.

Examples of recyclable plastic items without the recyclable plastic mark that will be added to the category of *recyclable plastic resources*: daily necessities made of plastic, CDs, DVDs, plastic stationery, and plastic toys excluding electric or battery-operated toys.

After-School Children's Classrooms for Schoolyear 2024

Nisshin City will start accepting applications for its After-school Children's Classrooms for schoolyear 2024 which starts in April 2024. The city offers the Comprehensive Children's After-school Plan to provide places for children to stay after school. The plan includes two services: 1) After-school Children's Clubs for children whose family members are not at home, and 2) After-school Children's Classrooms for all children. Please apply for the appropriate service based on your family situation.

The deadline for initial applications for After-school Children's Clubs was January 31. Though applications for use of children's clubs from April will be accepted until February 29 (Thurs), please note that you will be put on the waiting list if there are no vacancies.

Notes:

- 1) You need to apply for each schoolyear. Please make sure to apply during the following application period if you are presently using the service and hope to continue using the service in the next schoolyear.
- 2) Please make sure to carefully read the guide posted on the Nisshin City website before applying.

Application period: February 1 (Thurs) ~ February 29 (Thurs)

How to apply:

- 1) Apply via the Nisshin City Electronic Application and Notification System or
- 2) Apply at Conference Room 4 on the second floor of the City Hall between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. **Note:** Use of the Electronic Application and Notification System is recommended since you can apply easily

without visiting the City Hall.

Required items: Application form for registration and a copy of account transfer request form with a receiving stamp from a financial institution (Note: A copy of account transfer request form is necessary for each child. However, you do not need to submit the form if you have previously submitted a form for that child and no changes have been made.)

Forms: Forms necessary for application are distributed at the window of the Parenting Assistance Div. and After-school Children's Classrooms. Application forms for registration can be also downloaded from the Nisshin City website.

Account transfer request forms are available at branch offices of financial institutions in Nisshin City which handle account transfer.

The Nationwide Information Transmission Drill of J-ALERT; the National Early Warning System (全国瞬時警報システム(Jアラート)の全国一斉情報伝達試験)

Disaster prevention sirens will be sounded in Nisshin City on February 9 as part of the nationwide drill using J-Alert, the National Early Warning System. J- Alert communicates high-priority emergency information such as launch of ballistic missiles to the public by sirens and other means.

Date and Time: February 9th (Fri) around 11:00 a.m.

In the drill, warning sirens will be sounded at the following six sites in Nisshin: Nisshin Citizens Hall, Nisshin Nishi Junior High School, Takenoyama Elementary School, Ainoyama Elementary School, Higashi Elementary School, and Sagamine Reservoir. A fourteen-second siren followed by a pause will be repeated three times. The cancellation of the drill will be notified on the Nisshin City Website.


The Farmland Bank System

The Farmland Bank System was introduced in 2014 to cope with the nationwide problem of increasing abandoned farmland due to the aging of land owners and lack of successors.

Aim of the System

The aim of the Farmland Bank System is to utilize unused farmland. The system enables owners to register farmland that they can no longer manage in the bank, and prospective tenants to browse listed land to find desirable farmland to lease. Please feel free to contact the bank if you wish to lease farmland.

Notes: The farmland bank is involved only in the lease and not the sale of farmland.
