Municipal taxes are used to support your life, welfare and education. Delinquencies in payment reduce the city revenue. Sending reminders and demand letters increases unnecessary expenditure affecting various administrative services. Please don't forget to pay your taxes by the deadline.

If taxes are not paid in time

If taxes are not paid by the deadline, reminders and demand letters will be sent to you. If you still fail to pay, your property can be seized after investigations of assets are conducted as provided by law.

Tax payment is demanded in writing, by phone and at your door.



4. Investigations of assets

If you still fail to pay, your assets are investigated including your salaries, deposits, savings, and real estate.

Seized assets are converted to cash by public sale and allocated for taxes.
